FIFE

Otherwise known as the Kingdom of Fife, world famous for its golf and is home to Scotland's oldest university town St Andrews. The landscape varies from gentle hills and windswept cliffs to quaint fishing villages and long sandy beaches.

There is a great choice of long and short distance walks and several nature reserves from the Lomond Hills to the Pilgram Way and the Fife Coastal Path. Take the coastal path and you might be lucky enough to spot a grey seal or dolphin. The offshore islands of Inchcolm and Inchkeith are home to thousands of seabirds and at the mouth of the Forth. Off the coast of Fife, sits the Isle of May with its abundant puffins, common and artic terns. Later in the year, the island hosts the biggest grey seal gathering on the UK's east coast.



ANGUS & DUNDEE

Dundee is Scotland's first UNESCO City of Design and also home of the RRS Discovery and the V&A so well worth a visit and even better if you can combine your visit with an adventure in the surrounding Angus countryside.

Angus takes you from the glens to the sea and there is plenty to do from water sports and boat trips at the coast to exploring by bike or on foot in the beautiful Angus Glens.

Let's not forget the wildlife from golden and white-tailed sea eagles to deer, ptarmigan, grouse and mountain hare to the wonderous pink footed geese, artic terns, knots and sedge warblers which can be seen at the Montrose Basin an enclosed estuary of the river South Esk covering 750 hectares and home to over 80,000 migratory birds.



EDINBURGH & LOTHIANS

Edinburgh and the Lothians has something for everyone from the beautiful architecture of the city to the picturesque countryside of the Lothians

You do not have to travel far for an adventure whether that be sailing down the Firth of Forth, coasteering of the North Berwick coast or taking in some of the breath-taking wildlife wonders. Internationally important seabird colonies, including the Bass Rock gannets nest on the Forth's islands which can be accessed by boat and enjoyed from the Scottish Seabird Centre at North




SEE NEW PLACES AND LEARN **NEW SKILLS ON DRY LAND**
